DAY 1 Prague

DAY 3 Prague – Vienna

Leave Prague and head across to Vienna, the “City of Waltz.” Upon arrival, enjoy your free time and perhaps start discovering the city’s delights, from shopping to architecture to pastries. BD

DAY 4 Vienna

DAY 5 Vienna – Budapest

Set off for Budapest to admire this lively cultural centre. Upon arrival, start exploring all the main attractions of this stylish cosmopolitan city. You will see the Parliament, followed by the Royal Palace, the Castle Hill area, Fisherman's Bastion, the Matthias Church, Heroes Square, and Gellert Hill with its Citadel. DAY 6 Budapest
